AN ACT

- 1 Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An
- 2 act relating to the public school system, including certain
- 3 provisions applicable as well to private and parochial
- 4 schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the
- laws relating thereto, providing for schools to be kept open
- on Saturday to make up instructional days lost as a result of
- 7 inclement weather.
- 8 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 9 hereby enacts as follows:
- 10 Section 1. Section 1502 of the act of March 10, 1949
- 11 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949,
- 12 amended January 24, 1966 (1965 P.L.1508, No.529), is amended to
- 13 read:
- 14 Section 1502. Days Schools not to be Kept Open. -- (a) No
- 15 school shall be kept open on any Saturday for the purpose of
- 16 ordinary instruction, except when Monday is fixed by the board
- 17 of school directors as the weekly holiday, or on Sunday,
- 18 Memorial Day, Fourth of July, or Christmas nor shall any school

- 1 be kept open in any district during the time of holding the
- 2 teachers' institute for such district. Whenever Memorial day
- 3 shall be on a Sunday, the following Monday shall be a holiday.
- 4 (b) For the 1993-1994 school year, the board of school
- 5 <u>directors shall have the option of rescheduling instructional</u>
- 6 days on Saturday to make up instructional days lost from the
- 7 <u>adopted calendar because school was closed as a result of</u>
- 8 <u>inclement weather</u>. Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection
- 9 (a), if the board of school directors reschedules an
- 10 <u>instructional day on Saturday the schools may be open on Monday.</u>
- 11 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
