## AN ACT

1 2 3	Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, further providing for an informational sign in the rear of all school buses.
4	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5	hereby enacts as follows:
6	Section 1. Section 4552(b) of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania
7	Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
8	§ 4552. General requirements for school buses.

10	(b) Visual signals
11	(1) In addition to the applicable lighting requirements
12	of Chapter 43 (relating to lighting equipment) every school
13	bus shall be equipped with a uniform front and rear system of
14	red and amber visual signals for the warning and control of
15	traffic during route operations as provided in section 3345
16	(relating to meeting or overtaking school bus) and in
17	regulations of the department.

1	(2) Each bus shall be equipped with a reflectorized sign
2	or lettering, at least 20 inches high and 24 inches wide, be
3	applied directly to the rear of the body of each bus, stating
4	<u>"No passing when red lights flashing. \$500 fine and 60-day</u>
5	suspension." The sign will be affixed to the rear of each bus
6	as near as possible to eye level of passenger cars.
7	* * *
8	Section 2. This act shall take effect in 120 days.
