A RESOLUTION

1 Designating April 18 through 24, 1993, as "Week of the Young  
2 Child."

3 WHEREAS, The York Association for the Education of Young  
4 Children and other local organizations, in conjunction with the  
5 National Association for the Education of Young Children, is  
6 celebrating the "Week of the Young Child," April 18 through 24,  
7 1993; and

8 WHEREAS, By calling attention to the need for quality child  
9 care for all young children and families within this  
10 Commonwealth these groups hope to improve the quality and  
11 availability of such services; and

12 WHEREAS, The quality of services is primarily determined by  
13 the individual teachers and caregivers who perform this valuable  
14 work; and

15 WHEREAS, The work of early childhood professionals is not  
16 fully understood and is underappreciated; and

17 WHEREAS, Quality child care services can provide the basis

1 for a good beginning for children's sound growth and  
2 development; therefore be it

3       RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate April  
4 18 through 24, 1993, as "Week of the Young Child" and urge all  
5 citizens to recognize the valuable contributions of early  
6 childhood teachers and caregivers and to actively support the  
7 need for more and better child care within our community.
