A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing "Safe Boating Week" in Pennsylvania.

2 WHEREAS, More than 2.5 million Pennsylvania boaters turn
3 their thoughts toward another enjoyable boating season as the
4 cool days of spring turn into the long, hot days of summer; and

5 WHEREAS, Pennsylvania has opportunities for every type of
6 boating enthusiast, from canoeing down a remote stream, to
7 waterskiing on one of our many lakes, to sailing on Lake Erie,
8 to power cruising on the Delaware and Susquehanna Rivers; and

9 WHEREAS, All boaters, whether enjoying water sports for the
10 first time or continuing the nautical traditions of a boating
11 family, need to start the season with the basic knowledge and
12 skills required to ensure their own safety and the safety of
13 their fellow Pennsylvanians who will take to the water this
14 year; and

15 WHEREAS, Lives can be saved and personal tragedies averted
16 through the awareness, acceptance and observance of boating and

1 water safety rules and regulations, avoiding the use of alcohol
2 while boating, and being alert to the dangers surrounding the
3 operation of boats; and

4 WHEREAS, The Congress of the United States has recognized the
5 importance of recreational boating safety to the Nation by
6 declaring "National Safe Boating Week"; and

7 WHEREAS, The Governor of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
8 proclaims June 6 through 12, 1993, as "Safe Boating Week" in
9 Pennsylvania; therefore be it

10 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the
11 Commonwealth of Pennsylvania recognize June 6 through 12, 1993,
12 as "Safe Boating Week" in Pennsylvania and urge all boaters to
13 increase their knowledge of boating and to sharpen those skills
14 necessary to make every week this summer a "Safe Boating Week,"
15 remembering the theme of National Safe Boating Week--Boat Smart.
