12	1966, a position she held until her retirement in 1988; and
13	WHEREAS, Sister Antoun was the recipient of numerous awards,
14	including honorary doctorates from Mercyhurst College, Edinboro
15	University, Gannon University, Marymount Manhattan College, the
16	Pennsylvania College of Optometry and King's College, nomination
17	by Governor Casey as a Distinguished Daughter of Pennsylvania,
18	the Alexis de Tocqueville Award, the Gannon University

Education since 1980 and was president of the board for the past
