A RESOLUTION

- 1 Congratulating the American Legion on the momentous occasion of its 75th Anniversary.
- 3 WHEREAS, The American Legion is celebrating the 75th
- 4 Anniversary of its founding by a group of officers who served in
- 5 the American Expeditionary Forces in France during World War I;
- 6 and
- 7 WHEREAS, Originally proposed by Lieutenant Colonel Theodore
- 8 Roosevelt, Jr., for the purpose of boosting troop morale, this
- 9 organization of American veterans held its first meeting in
- 10 Paris in March 1919 with nearly 1,000 officers and enlisted men
- 11 in attendance; and
- 12 WHEREAS, Known then as the Paris Caucus, it was renamed The
- 13 American Legion and considered each soldier of the American
- 14 Expeditionary Forces a member of the legion; and
- 15 WHEREAS, The legion held a second organizing caucus in St.

- 1 Louis, Missouri, in May 1919; and
- 2 WHEREAS, A constitution was completed and headquarters were
- 3 set up in New York City, thus beginning its relief, employment
- 4 and Americanism programs; and
- 5 WHEREAS, Congress granted the legion a national charter in
- 6 September, and its first national convention was held in
- 7 Minneapolis, Minnesota, at which time officers were elected to
- 8 head the organization; therefore be it
- 9 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives congratulate the
- 10 American Legion on the momentous occasion of its 75th
- 11 Anniversary and commend its outstanding contributions to the
- 12 welfare of the nation's armed forces and the communities it
- 13 serves.
