A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing the contributions of the Carpenters Apprenticeship
2 School and designating the week of November 10 through 16,
3 1994, as "Carpenters' Apprenticeship Week" in Pennsylvania.

4 WHEREAS, The Commonwealth is always pleased to recognize the
5 outstanding contribution made by skilled craftsmen in this
6 Commonwealth; and

7 WHEREAS, Since its inception in 1954, the Carpenters
8 Apprenticeship School has offered quality instruction and
9 personal guidance to students aspiring to join the ranks of this
10 Commonwealth's skilled labor force; and

11 WHEREAS, The Carpenters Apprenticeship School is administered
12 by the Carpenters Joint Apprenticeship Committee and the
13 Philadelphia Metropolitan Council of the United Brotherhood of
14 Carpenters and Joiners of America; therefore be it

15 RESOLVED, That in recognition of the contribution made by the
16 Carpenters Apprenticeship School over the last four decades in
17 advancing the good and welfare of the organized labor movement
18 in this Commonwealth, the House of Representatives hereby

1 designate the period of November 10 through 16, 1994, as
2 "Carpenters' Apprenticeship Week" in Pennsylvania; and be it
