AN ACT

Amending Titles 24 (Education) and 71 (State Government) of the 2 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, providing for special 3 supplemental postretirement adjustments. The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 4 hereby enacts as follows: 6 Section 1. Title 24 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a section to read: § 8348.4. Special supplemental postretirement adjustment. 8 (a) Eligibility. -- An annuitant who: 9 10 (1) retired after October 1, 1975, and before December 31, 1984 JANUARY 1, 1985; 11 12 (2) has military service as set forth in section 13 8304(b)(1) or (2) (relating to creditable nonschool service); (3) is receiving or will receive retirement pay under 10 14 U.S.C. Ch. 67 (relating to retired pay for nonregular 15

- 1 service) for this military service; and
- 2 (4) has not purchased nonschool service credit for this
- 3 military service;
- 4 shall be eligible for this special supplemental postretirement
- 5 adjustment.
- 6 (b) Calculation of adjustment. -- The monthly amount of this
- 7 special supplemental postretirement adjustment shall be equal to
- 8 the final average salary multiplied by 2% multiplied by the
- 9 years of this military service divided by 12 multiplied by any
- 10 applicable early retirement or option factors.
- 11 (c) Adjustment paid. -- Upon receipt of a timely request by an
- 12 <u>eliqible annuitant, the system shall pay this special</u>
- 13 <u>supplemental postretirement adjustment monthly from the</u>
- 14 effective date of this section.
- 15 (d) Adjustment enacted after death of annuitant. -- No special
- 16 <u>supplemental postretirement adjustment enacted after the death</u>
- 17 of an annuitant shall be payable to the beneficiary or survivor
- 18 annuitant of the deceased annuitant.
- (e) Future supplemental annuities. -- This special
- 20 <u>supplemental postretirement adjustment shall be included in the</u>
- 21 total annuity, and this military service shall be included in
- 22 the total credited service in determining all future
- 23 supplemental annuities.
- 24 (f) Time limitations. -- An annuitant who is eliqible for this
- 25 <u>special supplemental postretirement adjustment shall have two</u>
- 26 years from the effective date of this section within which to
- 27 make a request to the system for the adjustment established in
- 28 this section.
- 29 (g) Court-ordered purchase of nonschool service.--If a court
- 30 of competent jurisdiction rules that an annuitant who is

- 2 <u>for this military service is eliqible under section 8304(b)(1)</u>
- 3 or (2) to purchase nonschool service credit for this military
- 4 service, this special supplemental postretirement adjustment
- 5 shall stop with the annuitant's purchase of nonschool service
- 6 credit for this military service, and the total amount of this
- 7 special supplemental postretirement paid to the annuitant from
- 8 the effective date of this section shall be subtracted from any
- 9 <u>increase</u> in the annuity caused by the court-ordered purchase of
- 10 <u>nonschool service credit for this military service.</u>
- 11 Section 2. Title 71 is amended by adding a section to read:
- 12 § 5708.4. Special supplemental postretirement adjustment.
- 13 <u>(a) Eligibility.--An annuitant who:</u>
- (1) retired after February 28, 1974, and before December <—

- 15 <u>31, 1984 JANUARY 1, 1985;</u>
- 16 (2) has military service as set forth in section
- 17 5304(c)(1) or (2) (relating to creditable nonstate service);
- 18 (3) is receiving or will receive retirement pay under 10
- 19 U.S.C. Ch. 67 (relating to retired pay for nonregular
- 20 service) for this military service; and
- 21 (4) has not purchased nonstate service credit for this
- 22 military service;
- 23 shall be eliqible for this special supplemental postretirement
- 24 <u>adjustment</u>.
- 25 (b) Calculation of adjustment. -- The monthly amount of this
- 26 <u>special supplemental postretirement adjustment shall be equal to</u>
- 27 the final average salary multiplied by 2% multiplied by the
- 28 years of this military service divided by 12 multiplied by any
- 29 <u>applicable early retirement or option factors.</u>
- 30 (c) Adjustment paid.--Upon receipt of a timely request by an

- 1 <u>eliqible annuitant, the system shall pay this special</u>
- 2 <u>supplemental postretirement adjustment monthly from the</u>
- 3 effective date of this section.
- 4 (d) Adjustment enacted after death of annuitant. -- No special
- 5 <u>supplemental postretirement adjustment enacted after the death</u>
- 6 of an annuitant shall be payable to the beneficiary or survivor
- 7 annuitant of the deceased annuitant.
- 8 (e) Future supplemental annuities.--This special
- 9 <u>supplemental postretirement adjustment shall be included in the</u>
- 10 total annuity, and this military service shall be included in
- 11 the total credited service in determining all future
- 12 <u>supplemental annuities</u>.
- 13 <u>(f) Time limitations.--An annuitant who is eligible for this</u>
- 14 special supplemental postretirement adjustment shall have two
- 15 years from the effective date of this section within which to
- 16 <u>make a request to the system for the adjustment established in</u>
- 17 this section.
- 18 (q) Court-ordered purchase of nonstate service. -- If a court
- 19 of competent jurisdiction rules that an annuitant who is
- 20 receiving or will receive retirement pay under 10 U.S.C. Ch. 67
- 21 for this military service is eligible under section 5304(c)(1)
- 22 or (2) to purchase nonstate service credit for this military
- 23 service, this special supplemental postretirement adjustment
- 24 shall stop with the annuitant's purchase of nonstate service
- 25 credit for this military service, and the total amount of this
- 26 special supplemental postretirement adjustment paid to the
- 27 annuitant from the effective date of this section shall be
- 28 <u>subtracted from any increase in the annuity caused by the court</u>
- 29 <u>ordered purchase of nonstate service credit for this military</u>
- 30 service.

- 1 Section 3. This act shall be retroactive to January 1, 1974.
- 2 Section 4. This act shall take effect immediately.
