AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 2 Statutes, providing for the erection of traffic-control
- 3 signals on the basis of accident experience.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Title 75 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 7 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
- 8 § 6122.1. Erection of traffic-control signals on the basis of
- 9 accident experience.
- 10 (a) General rule. -- Notwithstanding any other provision of
- 11 this title, the department shall erect a traffic-control signal
- 12 at the intersection of a State-designated highway and a local
- 13 road when the governing body of the municipality in which the
- 14 intersection is located submits to the department evidence that
- 15 <u>five or more reported accidents, of types susceptible of</u>
- 16 correction by a traffic-control signal, have occurred at the
- 17 intersection within a three-year period. In order to meet the

- 1 requirements of this section, each accident must have involved
- 2 personal injury or property damage to the apparent extent of
- 3 \$200 or more.
- 4 (b) Joint submission.--If an intersection is located in more
- 5 than one municipality, the municipalities shall jointly submit
- 6 the evidence required by subsection (a).
- 7 (c) Minimum vehicular volume. -- When the requirements of
- 8 subsection (a) are met, the department shall not consider
- 9 whether the volume of intersecting traffic at the intersection
- 10 would or would not warrant installment of a traffic-control
- 11 <u>device</u>.
- 12 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
