(C) LIMITATION. -- NOTWITHSTANDING THE PROVISIONS OF 4

SUBSECTION (B), FINANCIAL INSTITUTIONS SHALL ONLY BE REQUIRED TO 5 6 DISTRIBUTE INFORMATION AND APPLICATION FORMS TO APPLICANTS WHOSE 7 PROPERTY WILL BE LOCATED IN THE ANTHRACITE OR BITUMINOUS COAL 8 MINE REGIONS AS DESIGNATED BY THE COAL AND CLAY MINE SUBSIDENCE 9 INSURANCE BOARD.

10 Section 2. Effective date.

11 This act shall take effect in 60 days.
