## AN ACT

- 1 Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An
- act relating to the public school system, including certain
- 3 provisions applicable as well to private and parochial
- 4 schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the
- 5 laws relating thereto, "further providing for sabbatical
- 6 leaves.
- 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 8 hereby enacts as follows:
- 9 Section 1. Section 522 of the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30,
- 10 No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949, amended July
- 11 29, 1965 (P.L.255, No.147), is amended to read:
- 12 Section 522. Payments of Salaries of Professional Employes
- 13 Granted Leaves of Absence as Exchange Teachers Authorized;
- 14 Rights Preserved. -- Any board of public education or board of
- 15 school directors of any school district or vocational school
- 16 district of this Commonwealth is hereby authorized to pay any
- 17 professional employe the salary he would be entitled to if
- 18 teaching in the school district from which he is granted a leave

- 1 of absence to serve as an exchange teacher in any foreign
- 2 country or territory or possession of the United States of
- 3 America.
- 4 Any professional employe, while on leave as an exchange
- 5 teacher, shall be considered to be in regular full-time daily
- 6 attendance in the position from which the leave was granted,
- 7 during the period of said leave, for the purpose of determining
- 8 the employe's length of service, the right to receive increments
- 9 as provided by law, and the right to make contributions as a
- 10 member of the School Employes' Retirement Fund and continue his
- 11 or her membership therein, [the right to service credits toward
- 12 the time necessary for a sabbatical leave, ] and the right to
- 13 accumulate days of leave on account of illness or accidental
- 14 injury.
- 15 Section 2. Sections 1166, 1167, 1168, 1169, 1170 and 1171 of
- 16 the act are repealed.
- 17 Section 3. The act is amended by adding a section to read:
- 18 Section 1166.1. Sabbatical Leaves of Absence.--(a) As used
- 19 in this section, the following words will have the following
- 20 meanings:
- 21 <u>"Employe organization" shall mean an employe organization as</u>
- 22 defined in section 1101-A of this act.
- 23 "School entity" shall mean a school entity as defined in
- 24 <u>section 1101-A of this act.</u>
- 25 (b) The board of directors of any school entity located in
- 26 this Commonwealth may, at its sole discretion, adopt policies
- 27 for the granting of sabbatical leaves for reasons of
- 28 professional improvement or health. Such policy may, only with
- 29 the approval of a majority of board members, be a subject of
- 30 bargaining between the school entity and an employe

- 1 <u>organization</u>.
- 2 Section 4. This act shall apply only to any bargaining
- 3 agreement taking effect after January 1, 1995. Bargaining
- 4 agreements which took effect on or before January 1, 1995, shall
- 5 be enforced in accordance with sections 1166 through 1171 of the
- 6 act until such agreements expire.
- 7 Section 5. This act shall take effect immediately.
