## AN ACT

- Amending the act of March 4, 1971 (P.L.6, No.2), entitled "An 2 act relating to tax reform and State taxation by codifying 3 and enumerating certain subjects of taxation and imposing taxes thereon; providing procedures for the payment, 5 collection, administration and enforcement thereof; providing for tax credits in certain cases; conferring powers and 7 imposing duties upon the Department of Revenue, certain 8 employers, fiduciaries, individuals, persons, corporations and other entities; prescribing crimes, offenses and 9 penalties, providing for an exemption from filing a personal 10 11 income tax return. 12 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- hereby enacts as follows: 13
- 14 Section 1. Section 330 of the act of March 4, 1971 (P.L.6,
- No.2), known as the Tax Reform Code of 1971, is amended by
- adding a subsection to read: 16
- Section 330. Returns and Liability. -- \* \* \* 17
- (c) Notwithstanding subsection (a), a person sixty-five 18
- 19 years of age or older who has no income tax liability under this

- 1 article shall be exempt from the requirement to file a tax
- 2 return.
- 3 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
