AN ACT

- Amending the act of April 12, 1951 (P.L.90, No.21), entitled, as reenacted, "An act relating to alcoholic liquors, alcohol and 2 3 malt and brewed beverages; amending, revising, consolidating 4 and changing the laws relating thereto; regulating and restricting the manufacture, purchase, sale, possession, 6 consumption, importation, transportation, furnishing, holding 7 in bond, holding in storage, traffic in and use of alcoholic 8 liquors, alcohol and malt and brewed beverages and the 9 persons engaged or employed therein; defining the powers and 10 duties of the Pennsylvania Liquor Control Board; providing for the establishment and operation of State liquor stores, 11 12 for the payment of certain license fees to the respective 13 municipalities and townships, for the abatement of certain nuisances and, in certain cases, for search and seizure 14 15 without warrant; prescribing penalties and forfeitures; 16 providing for local option, and repealing existing laws," 17 providing for the shipment of certain alcoholic beverages 18 into Pennsylvania.
- 19 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 20 hereby enacts as follows:
- 21 Section 1. The act of April 12, 1951 (P.L.90, No.21), known
- 22 as the Liquor Code, reenacted and amended June 29, 1987 (P.L.32,
- 23 No.14), is amended by adding a section to read:
- 24 Section 307. Shipment of Certain Alcoholic Beverages into
- 25 Pennsylvania.--(a) The board shall require that all liquor and

- 1 <u>alcohol it purchases for subsequent shipment into Pennsylvania</u>
- 2 <u>from a foreign country is so shipped through a Pennsylvania sea</u>
- 3 <u>or lake port.</u>
- 4 (b) As used in this section, the term "foreign country"
- 5 shall mean a country which does not share a common border with
- 6 one or more of the forty-eight contiguous states of the United
- 7 States.
- Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days. 8
