AN ACT

1 Directing the Department of Environmental Resources to develop  
2 and implement a program for the suppression of native forest  
3 insect pests in residential areas; and making an  
4 appropriation.

5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania  
6 hereby enacts as follows:

7 Section 1. Duties of Department of Environmental Resources.

8 The Department of Environmental Resources shall develop and  
9 implement a program for the suppression of native forest insect  
10 pests in residential areas meeting the Bureau of Forestry Gypsy  
11 Moth Spraying Guidelines.

12 Section 2. Appropriation.

13 The sum of \$5,000,000, or as much thereof as may be  
14 necessary, is hereby appropriated to the Department of  
15 Environmental Resources for the fiscal year July 1, 1995, to  
16 June 30, 1996, to carry out the provisions of this act.

17 Section 3. Effective date.

1       This act shall take effect July 1, 1995, or immediately,  
2   whichever is later.
