AN ACT

- 1 Directing the Department of Environmental Resources to develop
- and implement a program for the suppression of native forest
- 3 insect pests in residential areas; and making an
- 4 appropriation.
- 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 6 hereby enacts as follows:
- 7 Section 1. Duties of Department of Environmental Resources.
- 8 The Department of Environmental Resources shall develop and
- 9 implement a program for the suppression of native forest insect
- 10 pests in residential areas meeting the Bureau of Forestry Gypsy
- 11 Moth Spraying Guidelines.
- 12 Section 2. Appropriation.
- The sum of \$5,000,000, or as much thereof as may be
- 14 necessary, is hereby appropriated to the Department of
- 15 Environmental Resources for the fiscal year July 1, 1995, to
- 16 June 30, 1996, to carry out the provisions of this act.
- 17 Section 3. Effective date.

- This act shall take effect July 1, 1995, or immediately, 1
- 2 whichever is later.
