 further providing for unfair practices.

 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 7 hereby enacts as follows:
- 8 Section 1. Section 5(a) of the act of July 22, 1974
- 9 (P.L.589, No.205), known as the Unfair Insurance Practices Act,
- 10 is amended by adding a paragraph to read:
- 11 Section 5. Unfair Methods of Competition and Unfair or
- 12 Deceptive Acts or Practices Defined.--(a) "Unfair methods of
- 13 competition" and "unfair or deceptive acts or practices" in the
- 14 business of insurance means:

- 16 (14) Failure of an insurer to pay for emergency room
- 17 <u>treatment if the treating physician certifies that the patient</u>
- 18 had a reasonable basis for believing that emergency treatment
- 19 was necessary.
