AN ACT

Amending the act of October 15, 1980 (P.L.950, No.164), entitled 1 "A supplement to the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.177, No.175), 2 entitled 'An act providing for and reorganizing the conduct 3 4 of the executive and administrative work of the Commonwealth 5 by the Executive Department thereof and the administrative б departments, boards, commissions, and officers thereof, 7 including the boards of trustees of State Normal Schools, or 8 Teachers Colleges; abolishing, creating, reorganizing or 9 authorizing the reorganization of certain administrative 10 departments, boards, and commissions; defining the powers and duties of the Governor and other executive and administrative 11 12 officers, and of the several administrative departments, 13 boards, commissions, and officers; fixing the salaries of the Governor, Lieutenant Governor, and certain other executive 14 15 and administrative officers; providing for the appointment of 16 certain administrative officers, and of all deputies and 17 other assistants and employes in certain departments, boards, 18 and commissions; and prescribing the manner in which the 19 number and compensation of the deputies and all other 20 assistants and employes of certain departments, boards and commissions shall be determined, ' implementing the addition 21 22 of section 4.1 to Article IV of the Constitution of 23 Pennsylvania; establishing the Office of Attorney General 24 elected by the citizens and setting forth powers and duties 25 of the Attorney General; creating an Office of General 26 Counsel and providing for legal services for Commonwealth 27 agencies; transferring, reorganizing or reconstituting 28 certain boards, commissions and agencies; placing certain 29 duties upon the courts and district attorneys; repealing 30 certain acts and parts of acts and making appropriations," 31 providing for the powers of agents of the Bureau of Narcotics 32 Investigation and Control.

33 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania

1 hereby enacts as follows:

2 Section 1. The act of October 15, 1980 (P.L.950, No.164),
3 known as the Commonwealth Attorneys Act, is amended by adding a
4 section to read:

5 Section 205.1. Powers of agents of Bureau of Narcotics
6 Investigation and Control.
7 Agents of the Bureau of Narcotics Investigation and Control
8 in the Office of Attorney General shall, in addition to other

9 powers conferred by this act or any other act, have the same

10 rights, powers and duties as police officers in this

11 Commonwealth. The keepers of jails and other places of detention

12 shall receive all persons arrested by agents of the Bureau of

13 Narcotics Investigation and Control until they are dealt with

14 <u>according to law.</u>

15 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
