- 22 amended by adding a section to read:
- 23 <u>Section 409. Additional benefits for certain employes.</u>
- 24 Notwithstanding any provision of this act, an employe who meets
- 25 <u>the following shall be eliqible for an additional twenty four</u>

1 <u>weeks of benefits:</u>

2 (1) Is one of two hundred or more employes discharged from

3 <u>one industrial plant within a thirty day period.</u>

4 (2) The discharge resulted from the closing of the plant or

5 <u>a major portion thereof.</u>

6 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.

SECTION 1. SECTION 4 OF THE ACT OF DECEMBER 5, 1936 (2ND

18 SECTION 2. SECTION 302(A) OF THE ACT IS AMENDED BY ADDING A
19 PARAGRAPH TO READ:

20 SECTION 302. ESTABLISHMENT AND MAINTENANCE OF EMPLOYER'S 21 RESERVE ACCOUNTS.--THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ESTABLISH AND MAINTAIN 22 FOR EACH EMPLOYER A SEPARATE EMPLOYER'S RESERVE ACCOUNT IN THE 23 FOLLOWING MANNER:

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(2.1) NOTWITHSTANDING THE PROVISIONS OF PARAGRAPH (1) OF
 THIS SUBSECTION, IF THE DEPARTMENT FINDS THAT AN INDIVIDUAL WAS
 SEPARATED FROM HIS MOST RECENT WORK FOR SUCH EMPLOYER DUE TO A
 CESSATION OF BUSINESS OF 18 MONTHS OR LESS CAUSED BY A DISASTER,
 COMPENSATION PAID TO SUCH INDIVIDUAL WITH RESPECT TO ANY WEEK OF
 UNEMPLOYMENT OCCURRING SUBSEQUENT TO SUCH SEPARATION SHALL NOT

1	BE CHARGED TO THE ACCOUNT OF SUCH EMPLOYER; PROVIDED, SUCH
2	EMPLOYER HAS FILED A NOTICE WITH THE DEPARTMENT IN ACCORDANCE

б	SECTION 3. THIS ACT SHALL APPLY TO DISASTERS WHICH OCCUR ON
7	OR AFTER THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS ACT.
