A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing the week of April 16 through 22, 1995, as "National
2 Medical Laboratory Week" in Pennsylvania.

3 WHEREAS, The American Society of Clinical Pathologists in
4 cooperation with other health care organizations is celebrating
5 "National Medical Laboratory Week" during the week of April 16
6 through 22, 1995; and

7 WHEREAS, The theme for this year's observance is "The Lab
8 Professional: A Key Member of Your Health Care Team"; and

9 WHEREAS, These highly trained professionals are the key to
10 early detection of disease, appropriate diagnoses and cost-
11 effective treatment, which is a major goal of health care
12 reform; and

13 WHEREAS, Medical laboratory personnel are the largest segment
14 of the allied health care field; and

15 WHEREAS, These highly trained and dedicated professionals are

1 the least publicized professionals in the health care
2 profession; and

3 WHEREAS, By observing "National Medical Laboratory Week" with
4 appropriate programs and displays, the public will become more
5 aware of the vital role that laboratory personnel play in the
6 health care field; therefore be it

7 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives recognize the
8 week of April 16 through 22, 1995, as "National Medical
9 Laboratory Week" in Pennsylvania and urge all Pennsylvanians to
10 take part in the programs that will be conducted by health care
11 organizations to commemorate this important observance.
