- 6 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives memorialize the
- 7 Congress of the United States to study the following:
- 8 (1) Whether or not European Common Market safety codes
- 9 pose a potential restraint of trade by requiring unrealistic
- 10 standards for products imported into the European Market.
- 11 (2) Whether or not similar restrictions should be placed
- 12 upon European imports into this country;
- 13 and be it further

- 15 the presiding officers of each house of Congress and to each
- 16 member of Congress from Pennsylvania.
