- 1 Urging the Governor and the Attorney General to seek
- 2 reimbursement for the Envirotest settlement.
- 3 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives urge the Governor
- 4 and the Attorney General to pursue every legal means at their
- 5 disposal to obtain full reimbursement from the Environmental
- 6 Protection Agency and the Federal Government for costs incurred
- 7 by the Commonwealth for payment of the settlement authorized by
- 8 House Bill No.48, Printer's No.2929 (1995), arising from the
- 9 legal actions against the Commonwealth by Envirotest Partners,
- 10 Envirotest Systems, Corp., and Envirotest Technologies, Inc., in
- 11 connection with the program of enhanced centralized emission
- 12 inspections mandated by the Environmental Protection Agency and
- 13 entered into pursuant to the act of December 16, 1992 (P.L.1250,
- 14 No.166) and the Federal Clean Air Act Amendments of 1990 (Public
- 15 Law 101-549, 104 Stat. 2399) and subsequent Environmental
- 16 Protection Agency regulations; and be it further

1 the Governor and the Attorney General.
