- WHEREAS, Bill Cowher, a native of Pittsburgh, is the head

- 4 WHEREAS, As head coach, Bill Cowher led his team to the 1995
- 5 American Football Conference Championship; and
- 6 WHEREAS, This was the first American Football Championship
- 7 title for the Pittsburgh Steelers since 1979; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Bill Cowher was the youngest head coach to ever take
- 9 any National Football League team to the Super Bowl, being just
- 10 38 years of age; and
- 11 WHEREAS, The American Football Conference Championship is
- 12 only one of many of the major accomplishments that Coach Cowher

- 1 has achieved in his illustrious career, including having been
- 2 named National League's 1992 Coach of the Year by the Associated
- 3 Press and the Sporting News; and
- 4 WHEREAS, Bill Cowher has not only distinguished himself as a
- 5 former college football player at North Carolina State, where he
- 6 was team captain and was voted most valuable player, as a
- 7 professional football player with the Cleveland Browns and the
- 8 Philadelphia Eagles, where he was selected by the Eagles as the
- 9 most valuable special teams player, and as head coach in the
- 10 National Football League, but also as a true family man as the
- 11 husband of his wife, Kaye, and father of three daughters, Meagan
- 12 Lyn, Lauren Marie and Lindsay Morgan; therefore be it
- 13 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives extend its best
- 14 wishes and congratulations to Bill Cowher, head coach of the
- 15 Pittsburgh Steelers, for his successes in his professional and
- 16 family life and wish him continued success and happiness in the
- 17 future.
