5	WHEREAS, There is reason to believe that hospitals in this	
6	Commonwealth are replacing nurses with less trained, lower paid	
7	aides; and	
8	WHEREAS, A recent investigation has revealed evidence of	
9	severe adverse effect on health care in this Commonwealth as a	
10	result of this "downskilling"; therefore be it	
11	RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives hereby establish	<
12	a select committee DIRECT THE HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES	<
13	COMMITTEE to study changes in the delivery of nursing services	
14	and the resulting impact on the quality of acute care in this	<
15	Commonwealth. The committee shall consist of 11 members of the	
16	House of Representatives to be appointed by the Speaker of the	
17	House of Representatives, six members of the majority party and	
18	five members of the minority party; and be it further IN THIS	<

- 2 RESOLVED, That the select committee HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES <-
- 3 COMMITTEE shall:
- 4 (1) Examine the extent of enforcement and violation of
- 5 current regulations and standards of nursing practice.
- 6 (2) Examine the extent to which the hospital
- 7 accreditation process adequately considers the "downskilling"
- 8 of acute care providers.
- 9 (3) Examine the adverse effect of this practice on the
- 10 capacity of physicians to render quality acute care.
- 11 (4) Examine nurse/patient ratios and their significance
- 12 for medical care;
- 13 and be it further
- 14 RESOLVED, That the Department of Health, the State Board of
- 15 Nursing and all other agencies of the Commonwealth shall provide
- 16 assistance upon reguest as the select committee HEALTH AND HUMAN <-
- 17 SERVICES COMMITTEE may deem appropriate; and be it further
- 18 RESOLVED, That the <del>committee</del> HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES
- 19 COMMITTEE may hold hearings, take testimony and make its
- 20 investigations at such places as it deems necessary in this
- 21 Commonwealth. Each member of the committee shall have the power
- 22 to administer oaths and affirmations to witnesses appearing
- 23 before the committee; and be it further
- 24 RESOLVED, That the committee HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES
- 25 COMMITTEE make a report of its findings and recommendations to
- 26 the House of Representatives on or before November 30, 1996.
