14	(5) "Public work" means construction, reconstruction,
15	demolition, alteration and/or repair work other than maintenance
16	work, done under contract and paid for in whole or in part out
17	of the funds of a public body where the estimated cost of the
18	total project is in excess of [twenty-five thousand dollars

(\$25,000)] two hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000), but 1 2 shall not include work performed under a rehabilitation or 3 manpower training program. Commencing on January 1, 1998, the prevailing wage exemption for a public work covered by this 4 5 clause shall be updated by the secretary as of January 1 of each year. The update shall be equal to the percentage change in the 6 7 Statewide average weekly wage. Such updates shall be cumulative. 8 * * *

9 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
