AN ACT

1 Providing for the sale of cigarettes; and imposing a penalty.

2 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
3 hereby enacts as follows:

4 Section 1. Sale.

5 A business which offers cigarettes for sale shall store the
6 cigarettes behind the store counter.

7 Section 2. Penalty.

8 A business that violates section 1 commits a summary offense
9 and shall, upon conviction, be sentenced to pay a fine of \$200.

10 Section 3. Effective date.

11 This act shall take effect in 60 days.
