AN ACT

1 Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An
2 act relating to the public school system, including certain
3 provisions applicable as well to private and parochial
4 schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the
5 laws relating thereto," providing for veterans' preference.

6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
7 hereby enacts as follows:

8 Section 1. Section 1904-B of the act of March 10, 1949
9 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949, added
10 December 19, 1990 (P.L.1362, No.211), is amended to read:

11 Section 1904-B. School Purposes.--(a) The Thaddeus Stevens
12 State School of Technology, located in Lancaster, Pennsylvania,
13 shall [continue to] provide for the postsecondary education and
14 training of veterans and indigent orphans.

15 (b) If a sufficient number of veterans and indigent orphans
16 qualified for admission pursuant to school standards fail to
17 apply, then the board of trustees of this corporation [may]

1 shall admit, first, other veterans, second, other deserving
2 persons, and, thereafter, orphans who may not be indigent[, as
3 the trustees in their best judgment may think proper].

4 (c) Those shall be deemed orphans who have lost either
5 parent.

6 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
