AN ACT

Amending the act of March 4, 1971 (P.L.6, No.2), entitled "An act relating to tax reform and state taxation by codifying and enumerating certain subjects of taxation and imposing taxes thereon; providing procedures for the payment, collection, administration and enforcement thereof; providing for tax credits in certain cases; conferring powers and imposing duties upon the Department of Revenue, certain employers, fiduciaries, individuals, persons, corporations and other entities; prescribing crimes, offenses and penalties," providing for a personal income tax return checkoff for breast and prostate cancer research; and establishing the Breast and Prostate Cancer Research Fund.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
hereby enacts as follows:
Section 1. The act of March 4, 1971 (P.L.6, No.2), known as the Tax Reform Code of 1971 , is amended by adding a section to read:

Section 315.1. Breast and Prostate Cancer Research Fund.--
(a) The department shall provide a space on the face of the

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individual income tax return form whereby an individual may
voluntarily designate a contribution of any amount desired to
the Breast and Prostate Cancer Research Fund.
    (b) The amount so designated by an individual on the income
tax return form shall be deducted from the tax refund to which
such individual is entitled and shall not constitute a charge
against the income tax revenues due the Commonwealth.
    (c) The department shall determine annually the total amount
designated pursuant to this section, less reasonable
administrative costs, and shall report such amount to the State
Treasurer, who shall transfer such amount from the General Fund
to the Breast and Prostate Cancer Research Fund.
    (d) The Breast and Prostate Cancer Research Fund is hereby
established as a separate account in the State Treasury. All
moneys in this fund are hereby appropriated on a continuing
basis to the Department of Health for breast and prostate cancer
research.
    Section 2. This act shall apply to tax returns filed for the
tax year 1997 and each tax year thereafter.
    Section 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
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
