8	act of November 26, 1978 (P.L.1212, No.286), referred to as the
9	Inspection of Employment Records Law, amended November 29, 1990
10	(P.L.596, No.149), is amended to read:
11	Section 1. Definitions.
12	The following words and phrases when used in this act shall
13	have, unless the context clearly indicates otherwise, the
14	meanings given to them in this section:
15	"Employee." Any person currently employed, laid off with
16	reemployment rights [or], on leave of absence or formerly
17	employed. The term "employee" shall not include applicants for
18	employment or any other person.
