AN ACT

- Amending the act of December 12, 1986 (P.L.1559, No.169),
 entitled "An act providing protection for employees who
 report a violation or suspected violation of State, local or
 Federal law; providing protection for employees who
 participate in hearings, investigations, legislative
 inquiries or court actions; and prescribing remedies and
 penalties," extending the application of the act to medical
 facilities.
- 9 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 10 hereby enacts as follows:
- 11 Section 1. The definitions of "employee," "employer" and
- 12 "waste" in section 2 of the act of December 12, 1986 (P.L.1559,
- 13 No.169), known as the Whistleblower Law, are amended and the
- 14 section is amended by adding a definition to read:
- 15 Section 2. Definitions.
- 16 The following words and phrases when used in this act shall
- 17 have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
- 18 context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 19 * * *

- 1 "Employee." A person who performs a service for wages or
- 2 other remuneration under a contract of hire, written or oral,
- 3 express or implied, for a public body or medical facility.
- 4 "Employer." A person supervising one or more employees,
- 5 including the employee in question; a superior of that
- 6 supervisor; or an agent of a public body or medical facility.
- 7 * * *
- 8 <u>"Medical facility." A hospital, nursing home, clinic,</u>
- 9 <u>clinical laboratory, medical training institution, physician's</u>
- 10 office, ambulatory surgical treatment center, mental health
- 11 <u>facility</u>, <u>residential</u> or <u>outpatient drug</u> and <u>alcohol</u> <u>treatment</u>
- 12 <u>center or other health care facility or institution that is not</u>
- 13 under the operation or control of a public body.
- 14 * * *
- 15 "Waste." An employer's conduct or omissions which result in
- 16 substantial abuse, misuse, destruction or loss of funds or
- 17 resources belonging to or derived from Commonwealth or political
- 18 subdivision sources or accounts of medical facilities.

- 20 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
