AN ACT

Amending the act of May 17, 1921 (P.L.682, No.284), entitled "An act relating to insurance; amending, revising, and 3 consolidating the law providing for the incorporation of insurance companies, and the regulation, supervision, and 5 protection of home and foreign insurance companies, Lloyds associations, reciprocal and inter-insurance exchanges, and 7 fire insurance rating bureaus, and the regulation and supervision of insurance carried by such companies, associations, and exchanges, including insurance carried by 9 the State Workmen's Insurance Fund; providing penalties; and 10 11 repealing existing laws, "further providing for long-term 12 care insurance. 13 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 14 hereby enacts as follows: 15 Section 1. Section 1105 of the act of May 17, 1921 (P.L.682, 16 No. 284), known as The Insurance Company Law of 1921, is amended by adding a subsection to read: 17 18 Section 1105. Disclosure and Performance Standards for Longterm Care Insurance. -- * * * 19 20 (d) All long-term care insurance policies shall provide, as 21 an optional benefit, coverage that would permit married couples

- 1 who have a long-term care policy covering both individuals to
- 2 assign that portion of unused coverage by one spouse to the
- 3 other.
- 4 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
