- 10 WHEREAS, Under the Radon Awareness and Risk Reduction Mini-
- 11 Grant Program, the various mini-grants ranging from \$500 to
- 12 \$10,000 will be awarded for projects that will increase public
- 13 and professional awareness about the health risks associated
