A RESOLUTION

1 Directing the Insurance Committee to investigate recent health
2 insurance premium rate increases for health plans affecting
3 senior citizens in ~~south-central~~ Pennsylvania. <—

4 WHEREAS, Health insurance premium rates for health plans
5 affecting senior citizens in ~~south-central~~ Pennsylvania have <—
6 recently increased; and

7 WHEREAS, Whether a valid rationale exists for these rate
8 increases is unclear; and

9 WHEREAS, It is important that senior citizens of this
10 Commonwealth can rely on equitable and fairly calculated health
11 insurance premium rates; therefore be it

12 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives direct the
13 Insurance Committee to investigate recent health insurance
14 premium rate increases for health plans affecting senior
15 citizens in ~~south-central~~ Pennsylvania and to recommend <—
16 appropriate action; and be it further

17 RESOLVED, That the Insurance Committee report its findings

1 and recommendations to the House of Representatives as soon as
2 possible.
