- Declaring July 27, 1998, as "Korean War Veterans Armistice Day"
- in Pennsylvania and urging all government agencies and 3
- citizens to fly the American flag at half staff on July 27,
- 1998, in honor of those Americans who died as a result of their service to the United States in the Korean War.
- 6 WHEREAS, The United States was engaged in the Korean War
- during June 1950 through January 1955; and
- 8 WHEREAS, The Korean War cost the lives of 54,246 Americans,
- 9 and 8,177 Americans are still listed as missing in action; and
- 10 WHEREAS, It is appropriate to remember the sacrifice made by
- those Americans in the service to their country and to raise 11

- 1 awareness of the Korean War; therefore be it
- 2 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives declare July 27,
- 3 1998, as "Korean War Veterans Armistice Day" in Pennsylvania;
- 4 and be it further
- 5 RESOLVED, That all government agencies and citizens of this
- 6 Commonwealth fly the American flag at half staff on July 27,
- 7 1998, in honor of those Americans who died as a result of their
