## A RESOLUTION

1 2	Designating October 14, 1998, as "Farm Women's Day" in Pennsylvania.

6	WHEREAS, Farm women have played a vital role in preserving
7	and enriching Pennsylvania's agricultural tradition and rural

9	WHEREAS, The Society of Farm Women, with 2,772 members in 159
LO	Farm Women Societies throughout this Commonwealth, has been a
L1	leader in promoting Pennsylvania agriculture since its formation
L2	in 1914; and
L3	WHEREAS, The contributions of farm women and the Society of

Farm Women to Pennsylvania's rich agricultural heritage are deserving of recognition and appreciation; therefore be it RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate October 4 14, 1998, as "Farm Women's Day" in Pennsylvania in recognition 5 of farm women and the Society of Farm Women of Pennsylvania for 6 their contributions to the agricultural way of life in this 7 Commonwealth; and be it further
