## AN ACT

Providing that employment shall not be conditional upon 2 membership or nonmembership in, nor upon the payment or nonpayment of money to, a labor organization; and providing 4 remedies and penalties. 5 The General Assembly finds that to require a person to be a member of, or not to be a member of, a private organization as a 6 7 compulsory condition of work or employment is not in accord with fundamental principles of individual liberty and freedom of choice. It is therefore declared to be the public policy of this 10 Commonwealth that membership or nonmembership in a labor union 11 should not be made a condition of the opportunity to work or to be or remain in the employment of any employer; that employees 12 should have the right to form, join, continue membership in or 13 14 assist labor organizations and should equally have the right to 15 refrain from forming, joining, continuing membership in or 16 assisting labor organizations; and that any agreement, express or implied, between employers and labor organizations, or any 17 practice whatsoever, which directly or indirectly makes 18

- 1 membership or nonmembership in a labor organization, or support
- 2 or nonsupport of a labor organization, a condition of employment
- 3 or continued employment is a violation of individual liberty and
- 4 freedom and is against the public policy of this Commonwealth.
- 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 6 hereby enacts as follows:
- 7 Section 1. Short title.
- 8 This act shall be known and may be cited as the Freedom of
- 9 Employment Law.
- 10 Section 2. Definitions.
- 11 The following words and phrases when used in this act shall
- 12 have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
- 13 context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 14 "Labor organization." Any organization, or any agency or
- 15 employee representation committee, plan or arrangement in which
- 16 employees participate and which exists for the purpose, in whole
- 17 or in part, of dealing with employers concerning grievances,
- 18 labor disputes, wages, rates of pay, hours of employment or
- 19 conditions of work.
- 20 "Person." An individual or a corporation, association,
- 21 company, firm or labor organization.
- 22 Section 3. Prohibited conditions of employment.
- 23 (a) Membership. -- No person shall be required to become or
- 24 remain a member of any labor organization as a condition of
- 25 employment or continuation of employment.
- 26 (b) Abstention from membership. -- No person shall be required
- 27 to abstain or refrain from membership in any labor organization
- 28 as a condition of employment or continuation of employment.
- 29 (c) Dues, fees and charges. -- No person shall be required to
- 30 pay or refrain from paying any dues, fees or other charges of

- 1 any kind to any labor organization as a condition of employment
- 2 or continuation of employment.
- 3 Section 4. Penalty.
- 4 Any person who, directly or indirectly, places upon any other
- 5 person any requirement or compulsion prohibited by this act, or
- 6 who makes any agreement, written or oral, express or implied, to
- 7 do so, or who engages in any lockout, layoff, strike, work
- 8 stoppage, slowdown, picketing, boycott or other action or
- 9 conduct, a purpose or effect of which is to impose upon any
- 10 person, directly or indirectly, any requirement or compulsion
- 11 prohibited by this act commits a misdemeanor of the third
- 12 degree, punishable by a fine of not more than \$1,000 or a term
- 13 of imprisonment of not more than six months, or both. Each day
- 14 of continued violation shall constitute a separate offense.
- 15 Section 5. Injunctive relief.
- Notwithstanding any other law to the contrary, any person
- 17 injured or threatened with injury by any action or conduct
- 18 prohibited by this act shall be entitled to injunctive relief
- 19 therefrom and to damages for any injuries sustained.
- 20 Section 6. Repeals.
- 21 All acts and parts of acts are repealed insofar as they are
- 22 inconsistent with this act.
- 23 Section 7. Effective date.
- 24 This act shall take effect in 60 days.
