AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 23 (Domestic Relations) of the Pennsylvania
- 2 Consolidated Statutes, providing for reports of child death
- 3 where abuse is suspected.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Sections 6343, 6347 and 6367 of Title 23 of the
- 7 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes are amended by adding
- 8 subsections to read:
- 9 § 6343. Investigating performance of county agency.
- 10 * * *
- 11 (c) Department reviews and reports. -- The department shall

- 1 conduct child death reviews and provide written reports on any
- 2 <u>child death where child abuse is suspected and where a county</u>
- 3 agency has investigated child abuse or neglect reports related
- 4 to the child or to other children of either of the child's
- 5 parents or has provided protective or general protective
- 6 services involving the child or other children of either of the
- 7 child's parents. Agency performance, including, but not limited
- 8 to, the investigation of prior child abuse or neglect reports,
- 9 assessment of risk, acceptance of the family for services,
- 10 provision of services, case closure and compliance with this
- 11 <u>chapter and related regulations, must be analyzed in each review</u>
- 12 and report. An explanation regarding the nature and extent of
- 13 the review shall be provided in each report. This ON AND AFTER
- 14 JULY 1, 2000, THIS CHILD DEATH review and report shall be
- 15 completed no later than three months following the date of the
- 16 <u>child's death, and a copy of each ORAL REPORT OF SUSPECTED CHILD</u> <-
- 17 ABUSE TO THE DEPARTMENT. A COPY OF EACH CHILD DEATH report shall
- 18 be housed in the appropriate Harrisburg office of the
- 19 department. This section does not preclude the department from
- 20 reviewing and providing a written report on any child death
- 21 where child abuse is suspected or confirmed and the agency had
- 22 no prior involvement with the child or the child's family.
- 23 § 6347. Annual reports to Governor and General Assembly.
- 24 * * *
- 25 (c) Reports on child deaths. -- The department shall prepare
- 26 and transmit annually to the Governor and to the General
- 27 Assembly a report on its findings and recommendations regarding
- 28 its child death reviews and reports conducted under section
- 29 <u>6343(c) (relating to investigating performance of county</u>
- 30 agency). The annual report shall include, but not be limited to,

- 1 the following:
- 2 (1) A breakdown of child deaths reviewed versus those
- 3 <u>not reviewed and a discussion explaining the lack of reviews</u>
- 4 <u>for some child deaths.</u>
- 5 (2) The regulatory compliance problems identified in the
- 6 course of the child death reviews and a discussion outlining
- 7 the actions taken by the department and the county agencies.
- 8 (3) The practice or decision-making problems identified
- 9 <u>in the course of the child death reviews and a discussion</u>
- 10 <u>outlining the actions taken by the department and the county</u>
- 11 <u>agencies</u>.
- 12 (4) The good practice, effective decision making and
- 13 regulatory compliance identified in the course of the child
- death reviews.
- 15 <u>(5) The numbers of license revocations, provisional</u>
- licenses and full licenses given to county agencies reviewed
- 17 under section 6343(c).
- 18 (6) Recommendations for statutory change or for
- 19 additional legislation to fulfill the purposes of this
- 20 <u>chapter</u>.
- 21 § 6367. Reports to department and coroner.
- 22 * * *
- 23 (c) Reports of child death.--In addition to the child abuse
- 24 report required under subsection (a), a county agency shall
- 25 <u>immediately provide information to the department regarding its</u>
- 26 involvement with the child and with either of the child's
- 27 parents when a child dies and child abuse is suspected. The
- 28 county agency shall inform the department of any history of
- 29 protective or general protective services provided to the child
- 30 or to other children of either of the child's parents by the

- 1 county agency under this chapter or by court order and shall
- 2 <u>inform the department if the child was in the agency's custody</u>
- 3 at the time of the child's death. The county agency shall
- 4 provide this information in writing on forms provided by the
- 5 <u>department within 48 hours of the oral report.</u>
- 6 Section 2. The Department of Public Welfare shall promulgate
- 7 rules and regulations implementing the amendatory provisions of
- 8 this act.
- 9 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
