## AN ACT

Amending the act of May 17, 1921 (P.L. 682, No.284), entitled "An act relating to insurance; amending, revising, and consolidating the law providing for the incorporation of insurance companies, and the regulation, supervision, and protection of home and foreign insurance companies, Lloyds associations, reciprocal and inter-insurance exchanges, and fire insurance rating bureaus, and the regulation and supervision of insurance carried by such companies, associations, and exchanges, including insurance carried by the State Workmen's Insurance Fund; providing penalties; and repealing existing laws," requiring casualty insurance companies to offer liability coverage for township officials for errors and omissions occurring while performing their official duties.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
hereby enacts as follows:
Section 1. The act of May 17, 1921 (P.L. 682, No.284), known
as The Insurance Company Law of 1921, is amended by adding a
section to read:

Section 206.3. Liability Coverage for Township Officials.--
All casualty insurance companies doing business in this
Commonwealth shall offer to provide liability insurance coverage
for township officials for errors and omissions occurring while

Section 2. This act shall take effect in 180 days.
