13	Section 1207.1. Instruction in CPR Required. The Secretary	<
14	of Education shall not issue any State certificates authorized	
15	by section 1203, entitling a person to teach in any public	
16	school, without the presentation of satisfactory evidence that	
17	the person has completed a course of instruction in

- 2 shall require such periodic renewal of instruction in CPR as may
- 3 <u>be deemed appropriate</u>.
- 4 <u>SECTION 1205.4. CPR INSTRUCTION.--(A) SCHOOL ENTITIES SHALL</u> <---
- 5 BE REQUIRED TO OFFER A CARDIOPULMONARY RESUSCITATION TRAINING
- 6 (CPR) CLASS ON SCHOOL PREMISES AT LEAST ONCE EVERY THREE YEARS.
- 7 THE COURSE SHALL BE OFFERED AS AN OPTION TO ALL EMPLOYES OF THE
- 8 SCHOOL ENTITY.
- 9 (B) COMPLETION OF TRAINING, INCLUDING TESTING OF SKILLS AND
- 10 KNOWLEDGE, SHALL BE DOCUMENTED BY THE SIGNATURE AND TITLE OF A
- 11 REPRESENTATIVE OF THE TRAINING ENTITY AND SHALL INCLUDE THE DATE
- 12 TRAINING WAS COMPLETED. DOCUMENTATION SHALL BE RETAINED IN THE
- 13 FACILITY IN THAT EMPLOYE'S FILE. TRAINING SHALL BE CONDUCTED BY:
- 14 (1) THE AMERICAN RED CROSS;
- 15 (2) THE AMERICAN HEART ASSOCIATION;
- 16 (3) AN INDIVIDUAL CERTIFIED TO CONDUCT CPR TRAINING BY THE
- 17 AMERICAN RED CROSS, AMERICAN HEART ASSOCIATION OR OTHER
- 18 CERTIFYING AGENCY, APPROVED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH; OR
- 19 (4) OTHER CERTIFYING AGENCY APPROVED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF
- 20 HEALTH.
- 21 (C) SCHOOL DISTRICTS MAY INCLUDE THIS TRAINING IN THE
- 22 CONTINUING EDUCATION PLAN SUBMITTED BY THE DISTRICT TO THE
- 23 DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION UNDER SECTION 1205.1.
- 24 (D) FOR PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION, A SCHOOL ENTITY SHALL BE
- 25 DEFINED AS A LOCAL SCHOOL DISTRICT, INTERMEDIATE UNIT OR AREA
- 26 <u>VOCATIONAL-TECHNICAL SCHOOL.</u>
- 27 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
