INTRODUCED BY PLATTS AND CASORIO, APRIL 19, 1999

AS REPORTED FROM COMMITTEE ON LOCAL GOVERNMENT, HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES, AS AMENDED, APRIL 20, 1999

AN ACT

Amending the act of July 31, 1968 (P.L.805, No.247), entitled, as amended, "An act to empower cities of the second class A, 3 and third class, boroughs, incorporated towns, townships of the first and second classes including those within a county 5 of the second class and counties of the second through eighth 6 classes, individually or jointly, to plan their development and to govern the same by zoning, subdivision and land 7 8 development ordinances, planned residential development and 9 other ordinances, by official maps, by the reservation of certain land for future public purpose and by the acquisition 10 of such land; to promote the conservation of energy through 11 the use of planning practices and to promote the effective 12 13 utilization of renewable energy sources; providing for the 14 establishment of planning commissions, planning departments, planning committees and zoning hearing boards, authorizing 15 them to charge fees, make inspections and hold public 16 17 hearings; providing for mediation; providing for transferable 18 development rights; providing for appropriations, appeals to 19 courts and penalties for violations; and repealing acts and parts of acts, " prohibiting the location of methadone 20 treatment facilities in certain locations. 21

- 24 Section 1. The act of July 31, 1968 (P.L.805, No.247), known
- 25 as the Pennsylvania Municipalities Planning Code, reenacted and

- 8 public playground, public park, residential housing area, child-
- 9 <u>care facility or place of worship</u>, CHURCH, MEETINGHOUSE OR OTHER
- 10 ACTUAL PLACE OF REGULARLY STATED RELIGIOUS WORSHIP established
- 11 prior to the proposed methadone treatment facility, one or more
- 12 <u>public hearings regarding the proposed methadone treatment</u>
- 13 <u>facility location shall be held within the municipality</u>
- 14 following public notice. All owners of real property located
- 15 within 500 feet of the proposed location shall be provided
- 16 written notice of said public hearings at least 30 days prior to
- 17 said public hearings occurring.
- 18 (c) This section shall not apply to a methadone treatment
- 19 facility that is licensed by the Department of Health prior to
- 20 May 15, 1999.
- 21 (d) As used in this section, the term "methadone treatment
- 22 facility shall mean a facility licensed by the Department of
- 23 Health to use the drug methadone in the treatment, maintenance
- 24 or detoxification of persons.
- 25 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
