AN ACT

1 Amending Title 34 (Game) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
2 Statutes, further providing for safety zones.

3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
4 hereby enacts as follows:

5 Section 1. Section 2505(c) of Title 34 of the Pennsylvania
6 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:

7 § 2505. Safety zones.

8 * * *

9 (c) Definition.--As used in this section, the term "safety
10 zone" means:

11 (1) Except as otherwise provided in paragraph (2)[,]:

12 (i) the area within 150 yards around and that area
13 which is below the highest point of any occupied dwelling
14 house, residence, or other building or camp occupied by
15 human beings, or any barn, stable, or other building used
16 in connection therewith; or

17 (ii) the area within 300 yards around and that area

1 which is below the highest point of any attached or
2 detached playground of any school, nursery school or day-
3 care center.

4 (2) When applied to properly licensed archery deer
5 hunters within any special area designated by commission
6 regulations or any area making use of any special permit
7 issued in accordance with this title or commission
8 regulations, the area within 50 yards around and that area
9 which is below the highest point of any occupied dwelling
10 house, residence or other building or camp occupied by human
11 beings or any barn, stable or other building used in
12 connection therewith and the area within 150 yards around and
13 that area which is below the highest point of any attached or
14 detached playground of any school, nursery school or day-care
15 center.

16 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
