1 2 3 4	Amending Title 42 (Judiciary and Judicial Procedure) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, providing for unauthorized publication of name or likeness; and establishing a right of action.	
5	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania	
6	hereby enacts as follows:	
7	Section 1. Title 42 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated	
8	Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:	
9	§ 8313. Unauthorized publication of name or likeness.	
10	(a) General ruleNo person shall publish, print, PRODUCE,	<
11	MANUFACTURE, display or otherwise publicly use for purposes of	<
12	trade or for any commercial or advertising purpose the name,	
13	portrait, VOICE, photograph or other likeness of any natural	<
14	person without the express written or oral consent to such use	<
15	given by:	
16	(1) such natural person;	

1	(2) any other person, firm or corporation authorized in	
2	writing by such natural person to license the commercial use	
3	<u>of such natural person's name or likeness; or</u>	
4	(3) if such natural person is deceased, any person, firm	
5	or corporation authorized in writing to license the	
6	commercial use of the decedent's name, PORTRAIT, VOICE,	<
7	PHOTOGRAPH or likeness, or if no person, firm or corporation	
8	is so authorized, then by any one from among a class composed	
9	of the decedent's surviving spouse and surviving children.	
10	(b) Right of actionIn the event the consent required in	
11	subsection (a) is not obtained, the natural person whose name,	
12	portrait, photograph, VOICE, PHOTOGRAPH or other likeness is so	<
13	used, or any person, firm or corporation authorized by such	
14	natural person in writing to license the commercial use of such	
15	natural person's name or likeness, or, if the natural person	
16	whose likeness is used is deceased, any person, firm or	
17	corporation having the right to give such consent, as provided	
18	in subsection (a)(3), may bring an action to enjoin such	
19	unauthorized publication, printing, PRODUCTION, MANUFACTURE,	<—
20	display or other public use and to recover damages for any loss	
21	or injury sustained by reason thereof, including an amount which	
22	would have been a reasonable royalty and punitive or exemplary	
23	damages.	
24	(c) ApplicabilityThe provisions of this section shall not	
25	apply to ANY OF THE FOLLOWING:	<
26	(1) the publication, printing, display or use of the	
27	name, PORTRAIT, VOICE, PHOTOGRAPH or likeness of any natural	<
28	person in any newspaper, magazine, book, news broadcast or	
29	telecast, or other news medium or publication as part of any	
30	bona fide news report or NEWS REPORT OR NEWS presentation	<—
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1	having a current and legitimate public interest and where	
2	such name or likeness is not used for advertising purposes;	
3	(2) the use of such name, portrait, photograph or other	<
4	likeness in connection with the resale or other distribution	
5	of literary, musical or artistic productions or other	
б	articles of merchandise or property where such natural person	
7	has consented to the use of such person's name, portrait,	
8	photograph or likeness on or in connection with the initial	
9	sale or distribution thereof; or	
10	(3) any photograph	
11	(2) A PHOTOGRAPH, VIDEO OR AUDIO RECORDING of a natural	<
12	person solely as a member of the public and where such person	
13	is not named or otherwise identified in or in connection with	
14	the use of such photograph. PHOTOGRAPH;	<
15	(3) AN EXPRESSIVE WORK REGARDLESS OF THE MEDIA IN WHICH	
16	THE WORK APPEARS OR IS TRANSMITTED, OTHER THAN WHEN USED OR	
17	EMPLOYED FOR A COMMERCIAL OR ADVERTISING PURPOSE;	
18	(4) MATERIAL THAT HAS POLITICAL OR NEWSWORTHY VALUE;	
19	(5) AN ORIGINAL WORK OF FINE ART;	
20	(6) AN ANNOUNCEMENT FOR A COMMERCIAL OR ADVERTISING	
21	PURPOSE FOR A USE PERMITTED BY PARAGRAPHS (3), (4) OR (5); OR	
22	(7) THE USE OF AN INDIVIDUAL'S NAME TO TRUTHFULLY	
23	IDENTIFY THE INDIVIDUAL AS THE AUTHOR OF OR CONTRIBUTOR TO A	
24	WRITTEN WORK OF THE PERFORMER OF A RECORDED PERFORMANCE UNDER	
25	CIRCUMSTANCES IN WHICH THE WRITTEN WORK OR THE RECORDED	
26	PERFORMANCE IS LAWFULLY PRODUCED, REPRODUCED, EXHIBITED OR	
27	BROADCAST.	
28	(8) THE USE OF THE NAME, PORTRAIT, VOICE, PHOTOGRAPH OR	
29	OTHER LIKENESS OF A DECEASED NATURAL PERSON PURSUANT TO	
30	SUBSECTION (A)(3), UNLESS SUCH DECEASED NATURAL PERSON WAS	
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1	DOMICILED WITHIN THIS COMMONWEALTH AT THE TIME OF THAT	
2	PERSON'S DEATH.	
3	(d) Time limitationsNo action shall be brought under this	
4	section by reason of any publication, printing, display or other	
5	public use of the name or likeness of a natural person occurring	
6	after the expiration of 40 years from and after the death of	
7	such natural person.	
8	(e) Consent by minorAny A consent provided for in	<—
9	subsection (a) may only be given on behalf of a minor by the	
10	guardian of the minor's person or by either parent.	
11	(f) Other remediesThe remedies provided for in this	
12	section shall be in addition to and not in limitation of the	
13	remedies and rights of any natural person under the common law	
14	against the invasion of such person's privacy.	
15	(G) LIABILITY OF OWNERS AND EMPLOYEES THE OWNERS OR	<
16	EMPLOYEES OF ANY MEDIUM USED FOR ADVERTISING OR COMMERCIAL	
17	PURPOSES, INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, A NEWSPAPER, MAGAZINE,	
18	RADIO OR TELEVISION NETWORK OR STATION, CABLE TELEVISION SYSTEM,	
19	BILLBOARD, TRANSIT AD AND GLOBAL COMMUNICATIONS NETWORK, BY WHOM	
20	ANY ADVERTISEMENT OR SOLICITATION IN VIOLATION OF THIS SECTION	
21	IS PUBLISHED OR DISSEMINATED SHALL NOT BE LIABLE UNDER THIS	
22	SECTION UNLESS IT IS ESTABLISHED THAT THOSE OWNERS OR EMPLOYEES	
23	HAD KNOWLEDGE OF THE UNAUTHORIZED USE OF THE NAME, PORTRAIT,	
24	VOICE, PHOTOGRAPH OR OTHER LIKENESS OF A NATURAL PERSON AS	
25	PROHIBITED BY THIS SECTION.	
26	(g) (H) DefinitionsAs used in this section, the following	<
27	words and phrases shall have the meanings given to them in this	
28	subsection:	
29	"Children." A natural person's immediate offspring and any	
30	children legally adopted by the person.	

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1	"COMMERCIAL OR ADVERTISING PURPOSE." A COMMUNICATION
2	DESIGNED TO INDUCE A PERSON TO USE, PURCHASE OR EMPLOY A
3	PARTICULAR PRODUCT OR SERVICE.
4	"EXPRESSIVE WORK." A LITERARY WORK, DRAMATIC WORK, FICTIONAL
5	WORK, HISTORICAL WORK, AUDIOVISUAL WORK OR MUSICAL WORK
6	REGARDLESS OF THE MEDIA IN WHICH IT APPEARS OR IS TRANSMITTED.
7	"Surviving spouse." The decedent's surviving spouse under
8	the law of the decedent's domicile at the time of the decedent's
9	death, whether or not the spouse has later remarried.
10	Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.

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
