- 1 Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania
- 2 Consolidated Statutes, imposing a penalty for persons not to
- possess, use, manufacture, control, sell or transfer
- 4 firearms.
- 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 6 hereby enacts as follows:
- 7 Section 1. Section 6105(c)(2) of Title 18 of the
- 8 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended and the section is
- 9 amended by adding a subsection to read:
- 10 § 6105. Persons not to possess, use, manufacture, control, sell
- or transfer firearms.

- 13 (a.1) Penalty.--Any person convicted of a felony enumerated
- 14 under subsection (b) or a felony under the act of April 14, 1972
- 15 (P.L.233, No.64), known as The Controlled Substance, Drug,
- 16 Device and Cosmetic Act, or any equivalent Federal statute or
- 17 equivalent statute of any other state, who violates subsection
- 18 (a) commits a felony of the second degree.

- 2 (c) Other persons.--In addition to any person who has been
- 3 convicted of any offense listed under subsection (b), the
- 4 following persons shall be subject to the prohibition of
- 5 subsection (a):

- 7 (2) A person who has been convicted of an offense under
- 8 the act of April 14, 1972 (P.L.233, No.64), known as The
- 9 Controlled Substance, Drug, Device and Cosmetic Act, or any
- 10 <u>equivalent Federal statute or equivalent statute of any other</u>
- 11 <u>state</u>, that may be punishable by a term of imprisonment
- 12 exceeding two years.

- 14 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
