1 2 3	Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, further providing for local authority to erect traffic-control devices.
4	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5	hereby enacts as follows:
6	Section 1. Section 6122(a) of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania
7	Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
8	§ 6122. Authority to erect traffic-control devices.
9	(a) General ruleThe department on State-designated
10	highways and local authorities on any highway within their
11	boundaries may erect official traffic-control devices, which
12	shall be installed and maintained in conformance with the manual
13	and regulations published by the department upon all highways as
14	required to carry out the provisions of this title or to
15	regulate, restrict, direct, warn, prohibit or guide traffic.
16	(1) [Local] <u>Except as provided in paragraph (3), local</u>
17	authorities shall obtain approval of the department prior to

erecting an official traffic-control device on a State designated highway except where department regulations
provide otherwise.

4 (2) [Local] <u>Except as provided in paragraph (3), local</u> 5 authorities shall obtain approval of the department prior to 6 erecting any traffic signal except in a municipality with a 7 traffic engineer qualified in accordance with department 8 regulations.

9 <u>(3) Notwithstanding any other provision of this section,</u> 10 <u>a local authority may erect a stop sign on a highway within</u> 11 <u>its boundaries without the approval of the department.</u> 12 * * *

13 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
