17	may only issue a citation for a violation of subsection (a) if

1	(1) the vehicle is unattended; or
2	(2) the vehicle is attended by an individual who is able
3	to remove the vehicle but who fails to do so immediately upon
4	request of the police officer.

б	Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
