A RESOLUTION

- 1 Declaring April 22 through April 25, 1999, as "Northeast
- 2 Pennsylvania Flower Show Days" in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, The Back Mountain Bloomers Garden Club is hosting
- 4 the 1999 Northeast Pennsylvania Flower Show April 22 through
- 5 April 25 at the 109th Field Artillery Armory in Kingston, with
- 6 all proceeds from the show to benefit the Northeastern
- 7 Pennsylvania Philharmonic; and
- 8 WHEREAS, The Northeast Pennsylvania Flower Show is recognized
- 9 and approved as a standard flower show by the Garden Club
- 10 Federation of Pennsylvania and the National Council of State
- 11 Garden Clubs, Inc.; and
- 12 WHEREAS, The Northeast Pennsylvania Flower Show is open to

- 1 the public so that everyone may witness the glorious spectacle
- 2 created by dedicated amateur and professional gardeners and
- 3 horticulturists under the theme "All Around the Town"; and
- 4 WHEREAS, Public participation in the Northeast Pennsylvania
- 5 Flower Show has grown from 200 entries in 1993 to over 800
- 6 entries in 1997 and over 5,200 persons visited the show in 1997;
- 7 and
- 8 WHEREAS, Past Northeast Pennsylvania Flower Shows have been
- 9 recognized with numerous top State and national awards,
- 10 including the National Council of State Garden Clubs Flower Show
- 11 Achievement Award for being one of the best flower shows in the
- 12 nation, the Garden Club Federation of Pennsylvania Superior
- 13 Flower Show Award and the Staging Award for a standing flower
- 14 show; and
- 15 WHEREAS, The Northeast Pennsylvania Flower Show is presented
- 16 through a total volunteer effort of more than 200 persons from
- 17 the community, including the Northeast Pennsylvania Orchid
- 18 Society, the Country Gardeners, the Cultural Council of Luzerne
- 19 County, the Laurel Garden Club and other organizations; and
- 20 WHEREAS, Our quality of life is enhanced as we understand how
- 21 the natural beauty of the environment and improved quality of
- 22 the air is not possible without the many beautiful plants and
- 23 flowers that surround us; and
- 24 WHEREAS, The following garden club goals are in evidence at
- 25 the Northeast Pennsylvania Flower Show, aiding in the protection
- 26 and conservation of natural resources, protecting civic beauty,
- 27 encouraging the improvement of roadsides and parks and advancing
- 28 the fine art of gardening, landscape design, floral design and
- 29 the study of horticulture; therefore be it
- 30 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives declare April 22

- 1 through April 25, 1999, as "Northeast Pennsylvania Flower Show
- 2 Days" in Pennsylvania and that all citizens throughout this
- 3 Commonwealth are welcome and encouraged to attend the Northeast
- 4 Pennsylvania Flower Show to experience the captivating beauty of
- 5 nature and splendor of the flowers during this show.
