A RESOLUTION

1 Designating April 11, 1999, as "Altrusa Awareness Day" in
2 Pennsylvania.

3 WHEREAS, Altrusa was incorporated in 1917, making it the
4 first service organization of business and professional women;
5 and

6 WHEREAS, There are currently 521 Altrusa clubs worldwide,
7 with over 17,000 members; and

8 WHEREAS, Altrusa has clubs in Dauphin, Centre, Allegheny, and
9 Philadelphia Counties in this Commonwealth; and

10 WHEREAS, Altrusa provides many services to the community,
11 including charitable work with youths, people who are mentally
12 handicapped and senior citizens; therefore be it

13 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate April
14 11, 1999, as "Altrusa Awareness Day" in Pennsylvania.
