- 5 WHEREAS, Special Olympics Pennsylvania was established as an
- 6 official Special Olympics chapter in May 1970 when a single
- 7 track and field meet was held at West Chester University for 135
- 8 athletes; and
- 9 WHEREAS, Special Olympics Pennsylvania has reached hundreds
- 10 of thousands of athletes and volunteers from every county in
- 11 this Commonwealth in the past three decades; and
- 12 WHEREAS, More than 27,000 children and adults with mental

- 1 retardation have participated in training and competition in 22
- 2 individual and team sports this year with assistance from more
- 3 than 40,000 volunteers in local, sectional and State events
- 4 leading up to the Summer Games, the largest State-level event;
