- 1 Extending congratulations to Penn State's women's rugby team for winning this year's national championship.
- 3 WHEREAS, The Lady Ruggers, Penn State's women's rugby team,
- 4 won the national title in May of this year by defeating
- 5 Princeton University in competition held in Tampa, Florida; and
- 6 WHEREAS, To arrive at the national title game, the Lady
- 7 Ruggers had to get past top-seeded Stanford in the semifinals,
- 8 after defeating fourth-seeded Marquette in the prior round; and
- 9 WHEREAS, The 31-22 victory over Princeton was the second
- 10 national championship for the Lady Ruggers, who had previously
- 11 won the national title in 1997; and
- 12 WHEREAS, The outstanding effort and spirit of determination
- 13 and cooperation demonstrated by this team should not go
