AN ACT

- 1 Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An
- 2 act relating to the public school system, including certain
- 3 provisions applicable as well to private and parochial
- schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the
- 5 laws relating thereto, " further providing for special
- 6 education payments to school districts.
- 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 8 hereby enacts as follows:
- 9 Section 1. Section 2509.5 of the act of March 10, 1949
- 10 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949, is
- 11 amended by adding a subsection to read:
- 12 Section 2509.5. Special Education Payments to School
- 13 Districts.--* * *
- 14 (qq) During the 2001-2002 school year and each school year
- 15 thereafter, each school district shall be paid:
- 16 (1) an amount to be determined by multiplying fifteen
- 17 percent (15%) of its school-age population residing in the

- 1 <u>district by one thousand three hundred fifteen dollars (\$1,315);</u>
- 2 <u>and</u>
- (2) an amount to be determined by multiplying one percent 3
- 4 (1%) of its school age population residing in the district by
- 5 <u>fourteen thousand five hundred thirty-five dollars (\$14,535).</u>
- Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days. 6
