## AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 23 (Domestic Relations) of the Pennsylvania
- 2 Consolidated Statutes, further defining "abuse."
- 3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 4 hereby enacts as follows:
- 5 Section 1. The definition of "abuse" in section 6102(a) of
- 6 Title 23 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended to
- 7 read:
- 8 § 6102. Definitions.
- 9 (a) General rule. -- The following words and phrases when used
- 10 in this chapter shall have the meanings given to them in this
- 11 section unless the context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 12 "Abuse." The occurrence of one or more of the following acts
- 13 between family or household members, sexual or intimate partners
- 14 or persons who share biological parenthood:
- 15 (1) Attempting to cause or intentionally, knowingly or
- 16 recklessly causing bodily injury, serious bodily injury,
- 17 rape, involuntary deviate sexual intercourse, sexual assault,

- statutory sexual assault, aggravated indecent assault,
- 2 indecent assault or incest with or without a deadly weapon.
- 3 (2) Placing another in reasonable fear of imminent
- 4 serious bodily injury.
- 5 (3) The infliction of false imprisonment pursuant to 18
- 6 Pa.C.S. § 2903 (relating to false imprisonment).
- 7 (4) Physically or sexually abusing minor children,
- 8 including such terms as defined in Chapter 63 (relating to
- 9 child protective services).
- 10 (5) Knowingly engaging in a course of conduct or
- 11 repeatedly committing acts toward another person, including
- following the person, without proper authority, under
- circumstances which place the person in reasonable fear of
- bodily injury. The definition of this paragraph applies only
- to proceedings commenced under this title and is inapplicable
- to any criminal prosecutions commenced under Title 18
- 17 (relating to crimes and offenses).
- 18 (6) Attempting to cause or intentionally, knowingly or
- 19 recklessly causing injury by means of mental or psychological
- 20 <u>intimidation</u>.

- 22 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
